Thank you for the opportunity to comment relating to the Fast Track process for the Drury Metropolitan development. In reading the engagement schedule and details regarding the raising of this project with our iwi representatives, it prompted us to look through our records relating to this project.

It appears the last meaningful engagement by the developers with Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki was in 2018, where a Cultural Values Assessment was commissioned with no further engagement beyond then.

The report in the Fast Track application states that during a hui for a different project, this significant project was raised with whomever the Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki representative was who provided no comment at that time. No date or name was given, which makes it difficult to determine who that would have been and what timeframe this occurred in which leads us to feel

discomfort regarding our being included as meaningfully consulted on something we have not been involved in, in great detail, since 2018.

In this light, we are unable to put our name to this project in support unless further detail can be provided.
