1. My full name is Jordan Thomas Walker. I am the Principal Geotechnical Engineer & National Geotechnical Manager at Kirk Roberts Consulting, based in Christchurch New Zealand.

[Along with my colleague Ollie Behrent, Saima Sakik prepared the report “Geotechnical Assessment Report – 122 Morven Ferry Road, Arrow Junction” dated 17 March 2026 (“**the Report**”) regarding geotechnical aspects of the application under the Fast Track Approvals Act 2024 (“**FTAA**”) by Ridgeburn Limited (“**the Applicant**”) for the Ridgeburn proposal (“**the Application**”). The Report was written by Saima Sakik, reviewed by Ollie Behrent, and authorised by myself. It was lodged as part of the Application on behalf of the Applicant. - (a) BSc Geotechnical Engineering & Geology, CPEng Geotechnical Engineering, CPEng Civil Engineer


- (b) I am a Chartered Professional Civil and Geotechnical Engineer with over 20 years of experience across New Zealand and abroad. I have a wide range of residential and commercial knowledge and a strong technical and practical understanding of construction, civil and geotechnical disciplines.

Experienced in geotechnical investigations and design inputs for multi-lot residential land developments across New Zealand, including deep investigations for land stability assessments and supervision of shallow investigations. Provided practical geotechnical recommendations for earthworks, foundation design, slope stability, and residential subdivision development from consenting through to construction.

3. While the Report has not been prepared in the form of evidence to be presented at a hearing, I confirm that, subject to the caveat set out in paragraph 6 below:
