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## Introduction

1. My full name is Leela Moses. I am a qualified archaeologist. I have a Masters of Archaeological Practice (Distinction) from University of Otago, obtained in 2022.
2. I have 11 years' experience as a Heritage Management, including 4 years as a consultant archaeologist undertaking research, survey, excavation, analysis and report preparation including archaeological assessments for development and infrastructure projects in both pre- and post - European contexts. I have worked for CFG Heritage since 2021. I am a member of the New Zealand Archaeological Association.

Relevant projects I have assisted on, including assessments, field work, investigation, analysis and reporting, include:

- Puhoi to Wellsford Extension Road (New Zealand Transport Association Waka Kotahi) as both a Kaitiaki and archaeologist.
