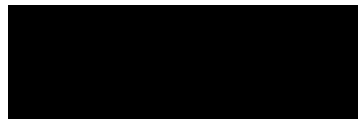

Introduction

1. My full name is Sharon Tenger. I am a groundwater specialist holding the position of Senior Hydrogeologist with ENGEO Limited. I hold the qualifications of a Bachelor of Science BSc Hons (Earth Sciences, 1989) from Oxford Brookes University, UK (formerly Oxford Polytechnic), and a Master of Applied Science MAppSc (Groundwater, 1996) from the University of New South Wales, Australia.
2. I have 36 years of experience working in the field of hydrogeology and contaminated land. I have provided hydrogeology assessments for numerous investigations and developments across New Zealand, Australia and Switzerland, including potable groundwater supply, consenting hydrogeologically complex contaminated sites for Auckland Council, MfE's Contaminated Site Remediation Fund 'Green Stream' groundwater contaminant plume project, and hydrogeological testing for NAGRA Switzerland's national radioactive waste disposal programme. I have also managed Auckland's State of the Environment groundwater quality research and monitoring programme and been groundwater Expert Witness for mining developments in the Environment Court.
3. In support of this fast-track application by Rangitootuni Developments Limited Partnership, I have co-authored the following material lodged in support of the application:
