## MAY IT PLEASE THE PANEL CONVENERS:

- This memorandum is filed on behalf of Port of Tauranga Limited, the applicant for the listed Stella Passage Development project (Project).
- 2. Further to the Panel Conveners' conference on 2 July 2025, we understand that the Conveners are going to seek clarification on aspects of the Ministry for the Environment's (MfE) Section 18 report on Treaty Settlements and other obligations for the Project (s 18 Report) following comments made by Counsel for the Ngāti Ranginui Iwi Society Incorporated.
- 3. As discussed in the conference, we are also concerned with an aspect of the s 18 Report and respectfully request that the Panel Conveners seek clarity from the MfE on this matter. Our concern is that the wording of the s 18 Report could be interpreted in a way that implies that the Project's footprint overlaps with the footprint of the Te Maunga o Mauao Mātaitai Reserve (Mātaitai Reserve).
- 4. We draw your attention to the following paragraphs in the s 18 Report which gives rise to our concern:
  - 23. The project area overlaps with Te Maunga o Mauao Mātaitai Reserve...

...

- 60. As noted at paragraph 23, the project area overlaps with Te Maunga o Mauao Mātaitai Reserve...
- 5. We confirm that the footprint of the Project does not overlap with the footprint of the Mātaitai Reserve. A map showing the proximity of the Mātaitai Reserve to the Project's footprint is annexed to this memorandum which illustrates that there is no overlap.

6. We respectfully request that the Panel Conveners seek clarification from the MfE on this matter.
