Thank you for the relevant information sent 23/1/26.

We wish to reiterate our concern that Arataki Road will not be able to cope with the volume of traffic that the new development will bring to the existing roading system.

Arataki Road is already a very busy road apart from the residents every day there is continuous traffic to Arataki Honey that includes the bee keepers, the many vehicles belonging Mainfreight, Pack & Save, New World and other businesses. During the cruise ship season buses visit there regularly as do other out of town buses throughout the year also school holidays families visit regularly.

Heavy vehicles also use Arataki Road as a through road to their destination.

We feel that Arataki Road will need to be widened to cope with the ensuing traffic problems that will occur. Allowance should be made for parking on either side of the road as we envisage cars from the new subdivision will be parking on Arataki Road as there will not be the space within the new subdivision to manage any extra cars from the residents or their visitors.

Emergency services must also be considered.
