As discussed at the conditions workshop with the Expert Panel on 23 June 2026 enclosed please find:

- An updated set of proposed consent conditions that reflect changes made as a result of the discussions at the conditions workshop. All changes made as a result of that workshop are highlighted grey. Ngāi Tahu Seafood has worked with Environment Southland to confirm the wording of Condition 11 and the suite of conditions relating to decommissioning (Condition 24 and associated conditions) and this set of proposed consent conditions reflects the wording agreed between the two parties. Minor typographical and grammatical changes have also been made to Conditions 'New' (before Condition 11) 17, 24A(c), 34(a) and Condition Y, but these have not been shown in track changes as they are not substantive;
- An updated explanatory table, that records the reasons for each of the updates, with the new text in the table also highlighted in grey;
- A letter from Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu in relation to the approach taken by Ngāi Tahu Seafood to the comments received from the Rakiura Tītī Islands Administering Body;
- An updated draft Environmental Monitoring and Management Plan that responds to the query raised by Dr Keeley on behalf of Environment Southland, with changes shown in track changes;
- An updated draft Seabird Management Plan, with changes made as a result of the comments process shown in track changes. There have been no subsequent changes to the draft SBMP;
- An updated draft Marine Mammal Management Plan, with changes made as a result of the comments process shown in track changes (in Appendix 4 of the MMMP only). There have been no subsequent changes to the draft MMMP;
- The draft Shark Management Plan as submitted with the substantive application. No comments were made on the Shark Management Plan. We note that the plan includes a heading labelled 'Adaptive Management'. As noted in NTS' response to Minute 3, adaptive management is not applicable to shark species and that title will be amended before the plan is finally submitted to

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Environment Southland for certification. Unfortunately, the author of the SMP is away from the office at the moment and we have not been able to contact her to facilitate getting that change made in time for this package of information to be provided;

- The draft Biosecurity Management Plan as provided to the Environmental Protection Authority on 12 March 2026. This version responded to some consultation conducted with Environment Southland after the substantive application had been lodged, with changes as a result shown in track changes.

We have provided all of the draft plans again in order to match the drafting of Condition 2 that is now proposed, which references draft plans provided to the Environmental Protection Authority on 1 July 2026. We therefore needed to provide the full suite of plans in order to make that condition drafting work.

We will provide a clean, renumbered and internally correctly cross-referenced set of consent conditions today as well, by separate letter, as requested by the Panel.
