

1. Notifications

- 1.1. Prior to the start of any on-site archaeological work, Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga must be notified of the date when work will begin. This notice must be provided at least 2 working days before work starts.
- 1.2. Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga must also be notified of the completion of the on-site archaeological work, within 5 working days of completion.

2. Archaeological Management Plan

- 2.1. The authority must be exercised in accordance with the Archaeological Management Plan attached to this authority at **Appendix X**.
- 2.2. All contractors undertaking site works must receive an on-site briefing in accordance with section 1.1 of the Archaeological Management Plan.
- 2.3. All contractors undertaking site works must hold a hard copy of the Archaeological Management Plan on-site for the duration of works.

3. Costs

- 3.1. The authority holder must pay the standard Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga charge-out rates for any staff time and mileage required to monitor compliance with this authority and to investigate any alleged breaches of the terms and conditions of it.
