



## MINUTE 5 OF THE PANEL CONVENER

## Commencement date Tekapo Power Scheme [FTAA-2503-1035] (1 July 2025)

- [1] I have considered the participants' memorandum dated 23 June 2025. At this stage, I do not propose to provide a further response, as I do not believe it would assist the process.
- [2] The participants raise preliminary issues of law. The view that the participants take on these issues will inform the commentary filed pursuant to s 53. Having received no advice to the contrary, I will assume the commentary period alone is sufficient.
- [3] In addition to the statutory period for commentary, the participants propose a 50 working day period. This is the minimum period required given:
  - (a) At the convener's conference, the Regional Council had yet to review the application and was unable to assist me with the scope of issues likely to arise.
  - (b) Genesis Energy Ltd and Canterbury Regional Council engaged on the substance of the application only last week.
  - (c) Genesis Energy Ltd and Canterbury Regional Council have both identified matters of law requiring determination. These matters do not concern the interpretation of the FTAA.

- [4] Waitaki Rūnanga advised yesterday that they have no concerns regarding the appointment of a prospective panel member with expertise in tikanga whom I identified.
- [5] The commencement date for the panel will be on or after 7 July 2025.
