Notice under section 30(3) of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024

Thank you for your letter dated 29 October 2025 notifying Porirua City Council that you intend to lodge a substantive application for resource consents under the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 (FTAA) for the Mt Welcome, Pukerua Bay, Porirua. We understand that the letter is your notice to us under section 30(2) of the FTAA.

Information requested

You requested that Porirua City Council, in accordance with Section 30 of the Act, provide written notice advising either:

- Whether there is any existing resource consent to which section 124C(1)(c) or section 165ZI of the Resource Management Act 1991 would apply if the approval were to be applied for as a resource consent under that Act; or
- That there are no existing resource consents of that kind.

Additional information sought

Your letter did not contain any information on the site of the proposed activities, or a description of those activities. Further information was provided to us in an email from Mr Torrey McDonnell on 10 November 2025, confirming the site and the proposed works. We understand the site for the purposes of the section 30 request is as shown in Appendix A and includes:

- Lot 1 DP 608433, Lot 1000 DP 608433 (34 Muri Road);
- Lot 1 DP 534864 (422 SH59);
- Lot 2 DP 534864 (422A SH59);
- Lot 2 DP 89102 (422B SH59);
- Part Lot 1 DP 89102 (422A SH59); and
- Road Reserve (SH59 corridor adjacent to the site).

We note that the site as described above differs from that set out in the listing of the project in Schedule 2 of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024, which states the 'Approximate geographical location' as '422A and 422B State Highway 59, Pukerua Bay, Porirua'. The listing therefore does not include 422 State Highway 59, legally described as Lot 1 DP 534864.

Based on the information that was provided by Mr McDonnell, we understand that the proposed works include:



- 949 residential allotments sized between 316m2 to 2386m2 (to enable 949 future dwellings) with an average lot size of close to 523m2;
- A commercial centre;
- Associated infrastructure including wastewater (including wastewater storage facilities), stormwater, water reticulation, roading, and pedestrian and cycling trails;
- Earthworks to establish the required finished surface levels for building platforms, roading, parks and drainage;
- Landscaping; and
- New intersection with State Highway 59.

Response to request

Porirua City Council does not issue resource consents under sections 12, 13, 14 or 15 of the Resource Management Act 1991. As such, Porirua City Council is not aware of any existing resource consent to which section 124C(1)(c) or section 165ZI of the Resource Management Act 1991 would apply in relation to the site.

For completeness, the resource consents that Porirua City Council have issued for the land identified in Appendix A are set out below.



Notice under section 30(3) of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024

Thank you for your letter dated 29 October 2025 notifying Wellington Regional Council that you intend to lodge a substantive application for resource consents under the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 (FTAA) for the Mt Welcome, Pukerua Bay, Porirua project at 422A and 422B State Highway 59, Pukerua Bay, Porirua 5026. We understand that this letter is your notice to us under section 30(2) of the FTAA. Thank you also for your correspondence to date, setting out the activities for which you will be seeking regional resource consents through your substantive application.

Section 30(3) of the FTAA requires that Wellington Regional Council, by written notice, advise you:

- (a) of any existing resource consent to which section 124C(1)(c) or 165ZI of the Resource Management Act 1991 would apply if the approval were to be applied for as a resource consent under that Act; or




Figure 2: Mt Welcome, Pukerua Bay, Porirua proposed development, Lucas block (excluding SH59 roundabout connection). Source: 1753-02-1000-Scheme-DRAFT-2025-10-29






Figure 3: Mt Welcome, Pukerua Bay, Porirua proposed roundabout connection on State Highway 59. Source: 1753-02-8300-SH59-ProposedRoading-DRAFT-2025-10-30
