



MINUTE 1 OF THE EXPERT PANEL

Project overview conference Sunfield Masterplanned Community [FTAA-2503-1039]

26 June 2025

- [1] The purpose of this Minute is to confirm the time and the details for an in person briefing from the applicant, with representatives from Auckland Council also invited to attend.

- [3] The purpose of the briefing is to familiarise the Expert Panel with:
 - (a) the content of the application for approvals;
 - (b) the content and structure of proposed conditions;¹
 - (c) the key points of evidence (technical reports, assessments and other information) provided in support of the application;
 - (d) confirming details and relevant matters for the site visit on 10.00am on 2 July2025;
 - (e) relevant legal tests and legal issues in contention; and
 - (f) other relevant matters.
- [4] During the briefing:
 - (a) the Applicant has an opportunity to present a high-level overview of the application; and
 - (b) the Expert Panel has an opportunity to ask any questions about the

application noting that by the time of the briefing the panel members may not have a complete understanding of all the documents supporting the application.

- [5] The Expert Panel requests that the applicant make available the appropriate experts they believe will assist in the Panel's understanding of the application in the briefing.
