- This memorandum on behalf of Trans-Tasman Resources
 Limited (TTR) seeks leave to file a further supplementary
 statement of evidence by Shawn Thompson.
- 2. TTR has become aware that in places the joint witness statements suggest that the processing of extracted seabed sediment aboard the IMV will create additional fines, and as a consequence the discharged tailings will contain more fines than the extracted sediments. This is incorrect.
- 3. Mr Thompson's supplementary statement seeks to provide additional information about the comminution² processes, to correct any misunderstanding on this topic.
