



MINUTE 1 OF THE EXPERT PANEL

Project overview conference Milldale [FTAA-2503-1038]

(26 June 2025)

- [1] The purpose of this Minute is to confirm the time and the details for an application briefing including the applicant and Auckland Council, and a site visit.
- [2] The briefing will be held on 10 July 2025 at 9:30am for approximately 1.5 hours. The site visit will follow on the same day for approximately two hours.
- [3] The purpose of the briefing is to familiarise the Expert Panel with:
 - (a) the content of the application for approvals;
 - (b) the content and structure of proposed conditions;¹
 - (c) the key points of evidence (technical reports, assessments and other information) provided in support of the application;
 - (d) proposed site visit details;
 - (e) relevant legal tests and legal issues in contention; and
 - (f) other relevant matters.
- [4] During the briefing:

- (a) the Applicant has an opportunity to present a high-level overview of the application;
- (b) the Expert Panel has an opportunity to ask any questions about the application noting that by the time of the briefing panel members may not

have had an opportunity to consider matters in detail. There will be further

opportunities in this process for that to occur.

[5] The Expert Panel requests that the applicant make available the appropriate experts

they believe will assist in the Panel's understanding of the application during the briefing.

[6] To facilitate the overview of the application referred to in paragraph 4(a) above, it

is suggested that the Applicant provide a short PowerPoint presentation to the EPA's

Application Lead, Daya Thomson, no later than 8 July 2025 and then speak to it at the

briefing.
