With regard to the monitoring are these completed whilst the quarry is not working, or when it is raining giving false/good results. Can water trucks be used on roadways over summer to reduce dust?

I commend the quarry for the new native planting next to 250 peachhill road boundary. It looks great and in years to come will act as a buffer. Will they continue with a weed & pest management program? Is there a plan to get rid of existing weeds (gorse and woolly nightshade) along peach hill road?

With regards to the planned solar panel farm, will they also plant the roadside to reduce visual effects to keep inline with the rural area and be a stepping stone for wildlife.
