



MINUTE 12 OF THE EXPERT PANEL

Further Requests for Information from Applicant, Auckland Council and persons invited to comment
Kings Quarry Expansion – Stage 2 [FTAA-2502-1018]

(10 November 2025)

The purpose of this Minute is to request further information as provided for under section 67 of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024. The Expert Panel requests that the parties listed provide the following information to the EPA, in each case not later than 12pm (i.e. midday) on Friday 14 November 2025.

Request for further information from Applicant

[1] **Noise and vibration:** the Barker & Associates 29 October memorandum responding to Panel Minute 8 provides at [12] a discussion of the potential for effects of noise and vibration cumulative to the Flat Top quarry.

Given the issues raised in comments received from invited parties as to the audibility of noise, including blasting, from the Flat Top quarry, please provide a further statement from an appropriate noise expert confirming that cumulative effects have been considered.

[2] **Conditions:** the Applicant's response to comments received from invited parties and to Panel Minute 10 suggest that the Applicant agrees to update its draft proposed conditions.

Please provide an updated suite of draft proposed conditions

Request for further information from Auckland Council

[3] **Conditions:** the Auckland Council 28 October memorandum of planning matters states at [7] that "[w]e would be happy to compile a tracked change document outlining the Council family's suggestions and additions to the proposed conditions".

Please provide a document showing the proposed changes and additions to conditions proposed by Auckland Council.

[4] **Additional visual simulations:** the Applicant's response to Panel Minute 8 included updated visual simulations and further landscape and visual assessment - refer Attachments 1 and 2 to the Barker & Associates 29 October memorandum.

Please provide comment <u>limited to</u> these updated visual simulations and resultant potential landscape and visual effects assessment.
