Ardgour Terrace Site	The approximately 27-hectare area located on the Bendigo / Ardgour terraces, outside the Shepherds Valley on agricultural land, which contains the non-operational infrastructure for the BOGP.
Ardgour Terrace Wetland	The approximately 0.5 hectare wetland within Shepherds Creek on the Ardgour terrace.
Ardgour Restoration Area	The approximately 1263-hectare area of Ardgour Station where ecological habitat enhancement restorations works are proposed as part of offsetting and compensation measures
Aukaha	A mana whenua-owned organisation that provides resource management services across the takiwā of the four Papatipu Rūnaka¹ and associated whānau and rōpū of the Otago Region.
Bendigo Conservation Covenant	Covers part of Bendigo Station and allows for public access from Thomson Gorge Road to the Come-in-Time Battery and access from Thomson Gorge Road to the Bendigo Conservation Area.
Bendigo-Ophir Gold Project	The topic of this fast-track approvals application, it covers approximately 568ha.
BOGP Consent Area	The entire Bendigo-Ophir Gold Project including exploration activities, mining operations within the Project Site, and all associated ancillary, monitoring, mitigation, off-setting and compensation activities and supporting infrastructure and activities within, and in the vicinity of, the Project Site as shown on Figure 1-4: Extent of the BOGP Consent Area. For the avoidance of doubt, the BOGP Consent Area includes the areas that are the subject of Concessions within Public Conservation Land.

Includes Ardgour Rise (Thomson Gorge Road realignment) and the construction zone for proposed predator proof fences. Buffers vary from 0-10 m in width for different component parts. For the purposes of the Terrestrial Invertebrate Survey and Mammalian Pest Report, an additional buffer was described.
Dispensation	An approval sought under the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations for activities that may impact fish or contravene the regulations.
Drive	A horizontal passage underground that follows along the length of a vein or rock formation opposed to a crosscut which crosses the rock formation.

	The silt pond will be designed like a water storage earth embankment dam with a decant tower to control outflow rates from the pond
Shepherds Stream Diversion	The 3.1 km length of Shepherds Creek that will be permanently realigned against the northern (true right) valley wall of Shepherds Creek during construction of the Shepherds Service Corridor in the form of a rehabilitated diversion channel.
Shepherds Valley Site	The reclamation of an approximately 3.1 km length of Shepherds Creek to establish an all-purpose service corridor, located within a visually screened location within the lower Shepherds Valley.
Significant Natural Area	Areas of significant terrestrial indigenous vegetation or significant habitats of indigenous fauna located either on land or in freshwater environments identified in District Plans.
Silt ponds	A pond for capturing run off water which has not intercepted potentially acid forming rock for the purpose of intercepting hydrocarbons and allowing the settling of sediments prior to discharge to the local environment.
Srex	Area of land with gold resource containing a Mineral Resource Estimation (2021) of 174,000oz of gold at a grade of 1.1g/t.

Ventilation	Necessary for air circulation and to provide emergency exits from the Rise and Shine Pit.
Water Treatment Plant	Used to treat water from mining operations prior to discharging this water into the Shepherds Clean Water Diversion Channel during mine closure.
