
MINUTE 11 OF THE EXPERT PANEL
Request to suspend processing of application
188 Beaumont Street FTAA-2604-1205
31 August 2026

Suspension of application

[1] By way of memorandum dated 31 August 2026 the applicant has requested suspension of processing of the application pursuant to section 64 of the FTAA.

[2] The purpose of the request is to allow the Applicant additional time to respond to the Expert Reports and the Panel's requests for further information, and for those responses to be filed after any expert conferencing on urban design, landscape and visual matters has occurred (should the Panel direct conferencing to occur).

[3] Under s64(4) of the Act, the Panel may, at its discretion suspend the processing of a consent application when a request is made. Where the Panel does grant a suspension, it must give written notice of the date on which processing was suspended to any of the parties specified under s 64(a) to (d) of the Act.

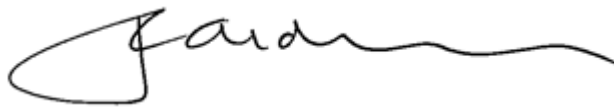
[4] The Panel has considered the memorandum from the Applicant and decided to grant the request. Processing of the 188 Beaumont Street application will therefore **be suspended from 11:59pm on 31 August 2026.**

[5] The Panel also records that Counsel for the applicant has confirmed that the Panel and administrative staff can continue to work on the application throughout the suspension period if they so choose. The Applicant also consents to any expert conferencing proceeding notwithstanding the suspension

[6] The Panel anticipates that, in accordance with the indication in the Applicant's memorandum, the Applicant will file a request to resume processing under section 65(1) of the Act prior to 11 September 2026, but notes that, until such a request is received, the suspension will continue.

[7] The Panel will be issuing further minutes in the next 24 hours addressing requests for further information and directing expert conferencing.

[8] For the avoidance of doubt, the deadline recorded in Minute 9 for responding to the Panel's Experts' Reports (5pm Tuesday 1 September 2026) is hereby vacated. Provision for a new deadline will be made in a later minute.
