
MINUTE 10 OF THE EXPERT PANEL
Minor Corrections
Foxton Solar Farm [FTAA-2510-1121]
11 September 2026

[1] On 14 August 2026 the Panel granted the approvals sought for the Foxton Solar Farm, subject to conditions (Decision).

[2] On 27 August 2026 Genesis Energy Limited (the applicant) sought minor corrections to several Decision conditions as follows:

- Condition A19 Table 4 (cross referencing errors);
- Conditions B28 and B29 ((cross referencing errors); and
- Conditions B14, B18(i)¹, B24(i)(ii), C4, C13, C19 and D1 (typographical errors).

[3] On 9 September 2026 Horizons sought minor corrections to the Decision and Conditions as follows:

- Condition C4 (typographical error)
- paragraph 22(a) (missing reference to RMA provision)

[4] The Panel noticed additional typographical and cross referencing errors in condition A36(c), B8 and B38.

¹ Genesis referred to condition B15 but we assume they meant B18.

[5] Section 89 of the FTAA provides that the Panel may, within 20 working days after issuing a decision document under section 88(1), issue an amendment to the document to correct minor omissions, errors, or other defects in it.

[6] The Panel has considered the requested minor corrections along with the additional errors it identified and is satisfied that all of the identified errors ought to be corrected and fall within the amendments contemplated by s 89 of the FTAA. Consequently, the minor errors referred to above have been corrected in a revised Decision and Conditions document which can be viewed here: <https://www.fasttrack.govt.nz/projects/foxton-solar-farm/the-decision>.
