## **SCHEDULE 3**

#### **Special Conditions**

#### General

1 The Concessionaire must conduct the Activity in accordance with the application dated [dd/mm/yyy].

#### **Track markers**

2 The Concessionaire must remove all track markers, flagging tape or other material used for the purposes of the Activity within one (1) month of the Activity being completed.

### **Expectations of the public**

- While undertaking the Activity the Concessionaire must not exclude or impede the public from accessing any sites, tracks or facilities.
- 4 If approached by members of the public while carrying out the Activity, the Concessionaire shall provide an explanation of why the Activity is taking place.
- 5 All monitoring equipment shall be situated so as not to be readily visible from any formed walking track and equipment shall not impede any public access to the area.

#### **Biosecurity Management**

- The Concessionaire shall comply with the biosecurity management and kauri dieback management sections of the Ecology and Landscape Management Plan Wharekirauponga Underground Mine at all times.
- 7 The Concessionaire will ensure that all equipment to be used for the Activities are clean and free of any exotic weed and seed material prior to entry onto public conservation lands.

#### **Monitoring**

- 8 Upon request, the Concessionaire must forward the following electronically to [permissionsupdates@doc.govt.nz and thames@doc.govt.nz]:
  - i. A copy of all raw data collated from the monitoring; and
  - ii. A one-page summary of the Activities undertaken.
- If the Grantor determines that the conditions of this Document or the effects of the Activity should be monitored, the Concessionaire shall meet: either the full costs of any monitoring programme that is implemented; or, if the Grantor determines that the costs should be

apportioned among several Concessionaires who use the same locations, part of the costs of the monitoring programme. These costs will include the Department's standard charge-out rates for staff time and the mileage rates for vehicle use associated with the monitoring programme.

# Removal of equipment

10 All equipment and structures must be removed at the expiry of this Concession.
