General comment on application and recommendations

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the substantive approval application for MILLDALE – Stages 4c and 10 to 13. Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga (HNZPT) has assessed the application, with input from specialist regional heritage staff, including those with Māori heritage, planning and archaeological expertise.

Overall, based on the information provided, we have no objection to the approval of the Non-complying resource consent application to enable the development of approximately 1,155 detached and terrace dwellings with a supporting Neighbourhood Centre and temporary wastewater treatment plant.

We recommend the following:

 That the resource consent application be approved in accordance with the documentation lodged with the Substantive Application, particularly Volume 1: Evaluation and Overview Report, Volume 5 Archaeological Authority and Volume 6 Fast Track conditions of Consent.

Our recommendations regarding the approval for an archaeological authority are addressed in the archaeological report we have provided separately to the Panel.



Cultural heritage values

Historical research has indicated that the proposed WWTP, Stage 4C and Stages 10 - 13 properties are situated in allotments that were granted to early European settlers in the mid-19th century and appear to have been in use for general agricultural purposes in the past. The potential for presence of archaeological sites associated with Māori occupation and settlement is considered low as the properties are located somewhat inland and not in close proximity to any navigable waterways.

The applicant has demonstrated to HNZPT's satisfaction that there has been engagement with all the relevant iwi within the Auckland Region, as follows

The following iwi have indicated that the development is in their direct rohe -

- Te Kawerau ā Maki who provided a Cultural Investigation Report in relation to the temporary wastewater treatment plant activity only. Te Kawerau ā Maki are not opposed to the development.
- Ngāti Manuhiri who provided a Cultural Impact Assessment and are not opposed to the
 development. The applicant has confirmed in the substantive application that the
 recommendations from Ngāti Manuhiri have been adopted as proposed conditions of consent.
 The requested Accidental Discovery Protocol has been included in the Archaeological
 Management Plan.

The project area does not contain any sites entered on the New Zealand Heritage List/Rārangi Kōrero or sites contained within Schedule 14 of the Auckland Unitary Plan

Archaeology

We acknowledge that the substantive application includes an approval for an archaeological authority. We refer the Panel to the report we have been directed to provide under s 51(2)(d) of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 for our comments on archaeology and any recommendations.
