The Devonport Borough Council being the Local Authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Devonport, by resolution declares that the provisions of Section one hundred and twenty eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the eastern side of that portion of Wynyard Street adjoining lots 23 and 24, part lots 13 and 14 of part Allotment 22, Section 2, Parish of Takapuna being all of the land in certificate of title, Volume 568, folio 73, Volume 625, folio 127 and Volume 568, folio 75, Auckland Registry, subject to the condition that no building shall at any time be erected on the said land within a distance of thirty three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of the said street.

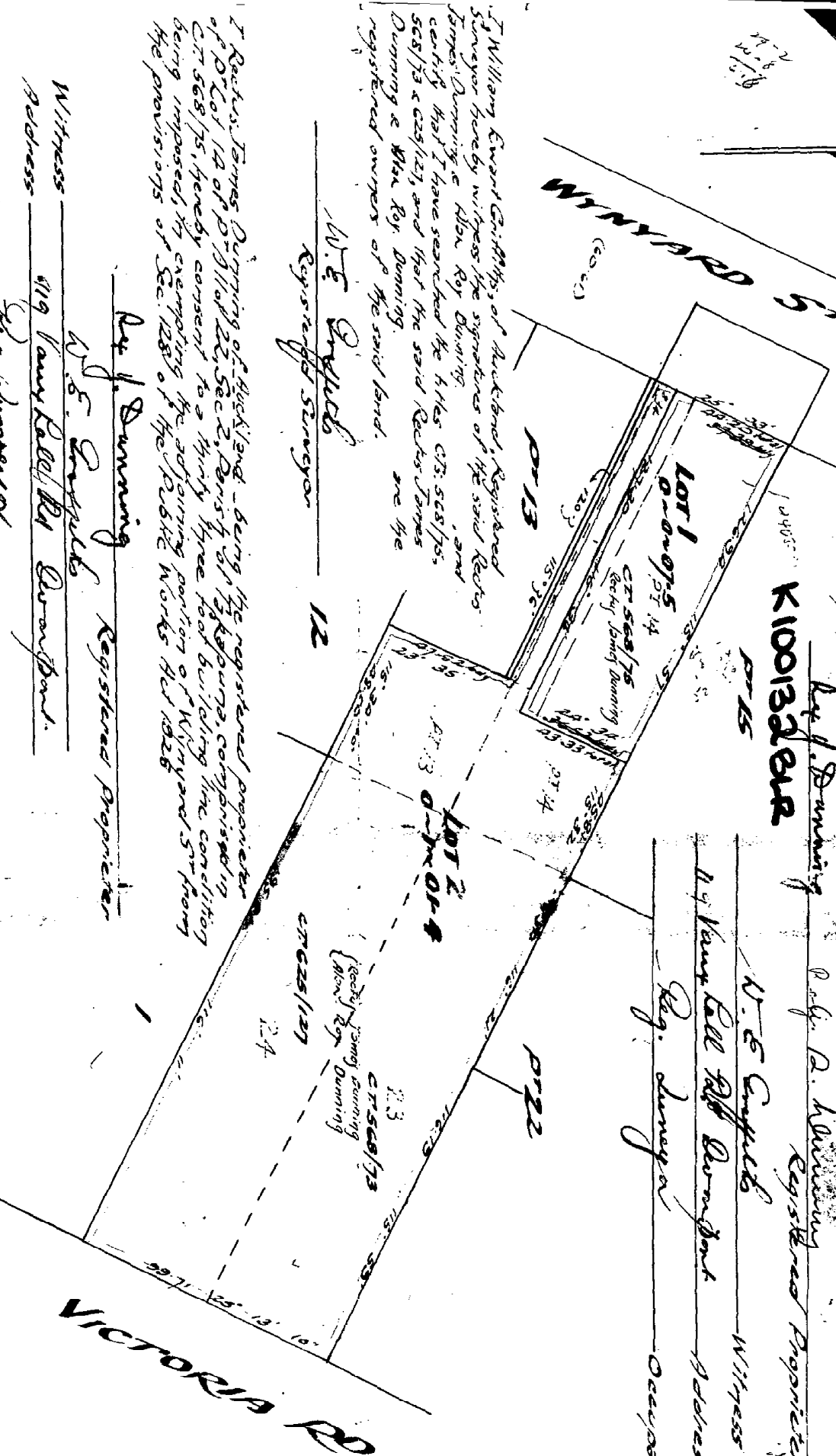
