Tēnā koe Mr Stevens,

- In its substantive application under the Fast Track Approvals Act 2024 ("FTAA"), the
 applicants for the Maitahi Village project say that they have consulted with Forest &
 Bird. In the conference with Panel Convenor Borthwick on 28 April 2025, the Panel
 Convenor noted that the applicant had consulted with affected parties including
 Forest & Bird.
- 2. Forest & Bird seeks to clarify that the only consultation was in 2022, in the context of Plan Change 28. There has been no consultation on any subsequent resource consent application (which now includes subdivision, earthworks, stream realignment and contaminated land disturbance consents). As such, any feedback that Forest & Bird gave on Plan Change 28 should not be treated as Forest & Bird's position on the substantive application.
