On behalf of the residents of Arataki, I am writing to follow up on our recent submission regarding the proposed housing development across the road from our community. Our residents remain strongly opposed to this due to concerns related in the letter we have provided.

We understand that under the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024, the Expert Panel is not required to hold a hearing. While we respect the process, we would like to formally request that the Arataki community be kept fully informed and involved at all stages, including:

1. Notification of any hearing should the Panel deem one appropriate. **(we think it is only fair to have a hearing)**
2. The opportunity to review and comment on draft conditions prior to the Panel finalising any decisions.

We have documented our concerns thoroughly in our submission. We respectfully request that these concerns are fully considered as part of the Expert Panel's deliberations.

Please confirm that the Arataki residents will continue to receive all future correspondence relating to this application, including draft conditions, so we can provide timely and considered feedback.

Notice of Application

On 23 July 2025, CDL Land New Zealand Limited lodged an application with the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) for the Arataki project under the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 (the Act). The application included applying for the following:

- an approval described in section 42(4)(a) or (d) (resource consent or designation).

On 12 August 2025 the EPA determined that the application complied with section 46(2) of the Act. On 26 August 2025 the EPA decided under Ministerial delegation that the application does not have competing applications [or existing resource consents] under section 47 of the Act and has now referred the application to the Arataki expert panel (the Panel) for processing and decision.

The Panel invites you to comment on the above application under sections 53 and 54 of the Act.

To assist timeframes to be met, email is the preferred method for response, if you are unable to submit your comments digitally, you may respond by post to Arataki Fast-track Application, Environmental Protection Authority, Private Bag 63002, Waterloo Quay, Wellington 6140.

Your comments must be received by the Fast-track Team no later than 13 November 2025. There is no right for you (or any other person) to seek a waiver of this time limit.

The Fast-track Team will forward copies of any comments received to CDL Land New Zealand Limited and the Panel.

If you comment on the application, the Panel will also invite you to comment on the draft conditions at a later stage. If you do not comment on the application, you will be notified of the decision on the application when it is made.

Important information

Your personal information will be held by the EPA and used in relation to the project consent application process. You have the right to access and correct personal information held by the EPA. Certain information in relation to your comments on the application will become public as the EPA will publish a copy of your comments on the Fast-track website.

If you are a corporate entity making comments on this application, your full contact details will be publicly available. For individuals, your name will be publicly available, but your contact details (phone number, address, and email) will not be publicly available.

All information held by the EPA is subject to the Official Information Act 1982. If you believe any of the information you provide is confidential or sensitive and should be withheld from publication, please highlight the information concerned and provide an explanation to support your request for withholding it.
