
**MINUTE 8 OF THE EXPERT PANEL
Request for further information**

**State Highway 1 North Canterbury – Woodend Bypass Project (Belfast
to Pegasus) Substantive Application**

[FTAA-2512-1157]

4 June 2026

[1] On 1 May 2026, the Panel received comments from Canterbury Regional Council (CRC) under section 53 of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 (FTAA). Within those comments, CRC made reference to multiple documents provided to it by the Applicant.

[2] As CRC's comments and the Applicant's responses rely on these documents, the Panel is unable to consider CRC's comments or the Applicant's response to those comments in any meaningful way, without access to those documents.

[3] Accordingly, the Panel now requests that the Applicant provide these documents under section 67 of the FTAA, including (but not limited to) the following:
