Re: Response to Wellington International Airport Limited request under Section 30 (2) of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024

Thank you for your email dated 15 July 2025 providing formal notification to Wellington City Council (the Council) under Section 30 (2) of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 (FTAA) that Wellington International Airport Limited (WIAL) will be applying for all approvals necessary for the Southern Seawall renewal project.

The information provided shows that the project will be located on land that is owned by WIAL and on land that is owned or administered by the Council and Land Information New Zealand. The specific properties that have been identified are:
