

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Term	Meaning
Curvey Return Access Road	Access and utilities road from mid station to curvey.
Doolans Expansion Area	The area proposed for expansion includes the total area where the Doolans Base Building and Doolans Lift Station and Return Terminal will be constructed, the ski trails, the gondola and associated buildings.
Doolans Basin	An alpine basin located on the eastern/backside of the Remarkables Ranges.
Doolans Ski Trail	A new intermediate ski trail in the Doolans Basin from the Helicopter Ridge midstation through to the Doolans Base Building.
Rastus Burn Mid Return Road Access	A new return access road and trail from the Helicopter Ridge midstation to Sugar Bowl.
Doolans Base Area	The area in and around the learners slope, base building, gondola lift station etc.
Doolans Base Building	The main building for the Doolans Basin expansion.
Doolans Gondola Station	Doolans Gondola Base Station will be located adjacent to the existing Rastus Burn Base Building.
Doolans Gondola Midstation	Doolans Gondola Midstation will be located on top of Helicopter Ridge.
Doolans Concession	A new concession authorising Doolans Gondola and supporting infrastructure that spatially traverses both the Remarkables Concession area and the Doolans Concession area and associated activities with the Project in the Doolans Basin and the Rastus Burn
Remarkables Concession	A variation to the existing concession 96118-SKI authorising activities associated with the existing Remarkables Ski Field in the Rastus Burn

Remarkables Ski Area	The official name of the Ski Field within the Remarkables mountain range.
Rastus Burn	The alpine basin located within the Rastus Burn Recreation Reserve and home to the existing Remarkables Ski Area.
Rastus Burn Base Area	The area around the Rastus Burn Base Building, car parks and maintenance areas.
Rastus Burn Catchment	The main water source in the Rastus Burn area.
Rastus Burn Base Building	The existing base building.
the Project or the Remarkables Upgrade and Doolans Expansion	The upgrade and development of Queenstown’s The Remarkables existing ski area infrastructure, and the expansion and trail development within the Doolans Basin
Site	The Queenstown’s The Remarkables existing ski area and associated infrastructure, including ski field access road, and the Doolans Basin
Ski Bus	NZSki operates shuttle buses from Queenstown and Frankton to the Remarkables Ski Area. All buses stop at the lower parking area at the start of the Remarkables Ski Field Access Road.
Wastewater System	The existing wastewater treatment system and associated disposal field, comprising three dispersal fields (collectively referred to as the “Wastewater System”), is located within Rastus Burn.
1:100-year flood event	A 1:100-year flood is a flood event that has a 1% chance of occurring in any given year, not one that happens only once every 100 years.
