

E.01 Summary of Mana Whenua Engagement

Date	Summary
23 April 2021	NZSki discussed Doolans aspirations with Ngāi Tahu Holdings representative.
14 May 2021	NZSki met with second Ngāi Tahu Holdings representative regarding Doolans aspirations.
4 April 2023	NZSki Met with Group Head, Strategy & Environment at Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu. Discussed Shadow Basin and Doolans aspirations and preferences on how we interact with Ngāi Tahu. Referred the Manager, Te Rūngana of Ngāi Tahu, acting in their capacity as representative of Kāi Tahu ki Tuawhenua.
24 October 2023	NZSki met with the Manager, Te Rūngana of Ngāi Tahu, acting in their capacity as representative of Kāi Tahu ki Tuawhenua. Referred NZSki on to Aukaha and Te ao Marama Incorporated as first point of contact. Discussed holding an in person hui at Kawarau / The Remarkables.
10 April 2024	<p>NZSki held a hui at Kawarau / the Remarkables with TAMI, Aukaha, and whānau representatives. A flyover of project area was presented.</p> <p>It was reiterated to NZSki to engage with Papatipu Rūnaka via Aukaha and Te ao Marama Incorporated.</p>
4 May 2024	<p>NZSki requested Aukaha and Te ao Marama Incorporated prepare a cultural values report for the Kawarau / Remarkables.</p> <p>NZSki also advised that an application had been made for Remarkables Ski Area Upgrades and Doolans Expansion Project to be listed in the Fast-Track Approvals Bill.</p>
27 May 2024	Aukaha requested information regarding the Remarkables Ski Area Upgrades and Doolans Expansion Project in order develop a scope of work.
21 June 2024	Remarkables Ski Area Upgrades and Doolans Expansion Project overview and preliminary layout plans provided to Aukaha and Te ao Marama Incorporated for comment and review. NZSki also queried if there was sufficient information for a cultural values report or cultural impact assessment to be prepared.
10 September 2024	Meeting with NZSki and Aukaha to discuss the Project. A further request for a cultural values report or cultural impact assessment was made.
14 March 2025	Met with Kaiwhakamahere Matua Whakaaetaka (Senior Planner - Consents), Aukaha and discussed the Remarkables Ski Area Upgrades

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	<p>and Doolans Expansion Project. Agreed to convene a hui at Kawarau / The Remarkables prior to the start of the 2025 ski season.</p> <p>Various attempts made to arrange the hui, however NZSki was advised that Papatipu Rūnaka are "considering the matter".</p>
9 April 2025	Correspondence received from Kahoki Mikaere on behalf of Kāi Tahu Tāhuna Fast Track Komiti - Project Director on behalf of Kāi Tahu ki Murihiku, initiating formal engagement on the Project and requesting a meeting.
30 May 2025	NZSki met with Kāi Tahu Tāhuna Fast Track Komiti - Project Director. Advised that the seven Papatipu Rūnaka were establishing a Tāhuna Fast Track Komiti to act as liaison between NZSki and Papatipu Rūnaka.
16 July 2025	Discussion between NZSki and Kāi Tahu Tāhuna Fast Track Komiti - Project Director regarding engagement. Was advised that Kauati was working locally with other Fast Track Applicants.
21 July 2025	NZSki signs process agreement with Kā Rūnaka.
27 August 2025	NZSki provided a project brief to Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu, Aukaha, Te ao Marama Incorporated, and Tāhuna Fast Track Komiti Project Direction outlining the substantive application and seeking engagement on the Project.
1 October 2025	NZSki meets within Te Tapu o Tane to discuss the Project.
3 December 2025	Online meeting with NZSki and Kā Rūnaka representative to discuss the Project and next steps.
12 December 2025	Preliminary sharing of information with Kā Rūnaka representative regarding technical experts and agenda for a wānanga in the New Year.
23 January 2026	Hui and site visit held at Kawarau / the Remarkables with representatives of Kā Rūnaka.
30 January 2026	Information regarding the Project provided to Kā Rūnaka representatives, including project overview presentation, list of technical assessments and the scope of works for the technical assessments.
11 February 2026	Preliminary meeting held between NZSki iwi and planning consultant, and Kā Rūnaka representative regarding the scope of a Treaty Impact Assessment.

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	Cost estimate provided by Kā Rūnaka representative regarding the resourcing inputs for the Project.
20 February 2026	Discussion between Kā Rūnaka representative and NZSki regarding costs. Follow up correspondence sent by NZSki.
27 February 2026	Kā Rūnaka representative response to NZSki's correspondence regarding costs.
6 March 2026	NZSki further responds to correspondence regarding costs.
10 March 2026	NZSki formally notifies Kā Rūnaka of its intention to file a substantive application under section 29 of the Fast-Track Amendment Act.
7 April 2026	Correspondence from Chairs of Araiteuru and Murihiku Papatipu Rūnanga received termination of process agreement.
13 April 2026	NZSki respond to termination of process agreement and request consideration of alternative approaches to engagement.
16 April 2026	Copy of four draft technical assessments provided to representative of Kā Rūnaka.
14 May 2026	NZSki reconfirms its commitment to establishing a long term relationship with Kā Rūnaka and invites the establishment of a mana whenua advisory group.
