
MINUTE 22 OF THE EXPERT PANEL

Post Panel-Facilitated Conference Requests for Information
Central and Southern Block Mining Project [FTAA-2512-1153]

(28 July 2026)

- [1] The purpose of this Minute is to request information from the Applicant and experts of all parties who attended the Panel Facilitated Conference on 22-23 July 2026 in Hamilton.
- [2] The information requested and parties to provide the information is set out in Appendix 1.
- [3] The information sought by the Panel is specific and targeted at the wording of conditions. Where conferencing is required, the parties are to organise their own process. The Panel considers that the subject matter of the requests is well known to the parties and that the parties' respective experts know each other sufficiently well and are sufficiently experienced so as not to require this process to be facilitated. In terms of initiating the process, the obligation is on the Applicant's expert in each case.
- [4] The parties' agreement on the information sought is highly desirable. However, if differences remain in parameters or specific wording then the Panel is to be advised of these differences, and the reasons for them, in the usual form of a joint witness statement.
- [5] The Panel will consider any clarification questions on the information sought as a matter of urgency.
- [6] The Panel requests that the RFI response is received by 5pm Tuesday 4 August 2026, with primary responsibility for coordinating and filing this response on the Applicant.
