Applicant briefing and site visit, section 67 further information request and invitations to comment, and acknowledgement of Applicant's memorandum
Takitimu North Link – Stage 2

Applicant briefing and site visit

[1] The Panel attended an on-line briefing with Applicant representatives on 30 October. The Applicant's representatives presented a series of slides which provided an overview of the project area and the approvals sought. The Panel asked questions to assist it in obtaining an overview of the Application prior to attending the site visit.

[2] The Panel Chair (Mary Hill) and member Euan Williams attended a site visit on 3 November. Due to sustaining a recent injury, member Juliane Chetham was unable to attend. A separate site visit will be arranged for her over the coming weeks. The Panel was escorted by the Applicant's planning consultant, John Olliver. A representative of the EPA, Stephanie Bougen, also attended. Following a brief orientation at the site office, the Panel was transported along the project area and surrounding land in Mr Olliver's vehicle. The Panel also walked to (or within view of) various sites of interest including the proposed lizard release area and ecological restoration areas, the Powerco sub-station, and I'Anson Reserve.

[3] The site visit assisted the Panel in determining which parties to invite comments from and whether to appoint technical or specialist advisors. The Panel is in the process of confirming its requirements for technical advice, and a separate Minute will be issued in

relation to that matter once confirmed.

Section 67 further information request and invitations to comment

[4] To assist the Panel in exercising its discretion whether to invite any additional parties to comment on the Application, over and above those required to be invited pursuant to the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 (FTAA), the Panel directed the EPA to request further information from the Applicant pursuant to section 67 of the FTAA in relation to parties or buildings potentially affected by daytime noise levels and vibration levels with reference to the Assessment of Acoustic Effects report provided with the Application. That information was requested on 3 November 2025. The Applicant responded on 7 November, providing a list of addresses, legal descriptions and owners of the relevant properties. The Applicant advised that only one property included in that list was not previously identified by the Applicant as being an owner or occupier of land within or adjacent to the designation boundary. That property (474/474A Ōmokoroa Road) is owned by Western Bay of Plenty District Council (**WBOPDC**). The Panel observes that WBOPDC is one of the relevant local authorities which it is required to invite comments from under section 53(2) of the FTAA.

[5] In accordance with section 53(2) of the FTAA, the Panel must invite comments on the substantive application from persons listed in sections 53(2) (a) to (n) of the Act. **Appendix 1** to this Minute provides the list of prescribed persons relevant to this project. The Panel wishes to record the following matters in relation to those prescribed persons:

- (a) Pirirākau Incorporated Society (now Pirirākau Tribal Authority Incorporated) and Ngāti Taka / Te Uho o Ngāti Taka have been included in the list of relevant Treaty entities pursuant to s53(2)(c). Those parties are considered by the Panel to fall within the ambit of s53(2)(c), being an entity that has an interest under a Treaty settlement within the area to which the substantive application relates and an entity operating in a collective arrangement, provided for under a Treaty settlement, that relates to that area.

- (b) When interpreting the meaning of “land adjacent” to the land to which the substantive application relates, for the purposes of section 53(2)(h) and (i), the Panel has had regard to the EPA guidance document relating to “identifying adjacent land” (June 2025 revision) and has exercised its judgement to include land that does not have a common boundary but is close enough to form part of the context of the application site and could be considered adjacent (such as land separated by a road, rail corridor, or watercourse).
- (c) The EPA received an unsolicited letter from Powerco dated **8 May 2025** advising that Powerco considers that it should be invited to comment on the application because it owns a designated substation located on or adjacent to the project site. The EPA provided the letter to the Panel for its consideration and it will be published on the EPA’s website. Notwithstanding this correspondence, the Panel is required under section 53(2)(l) to direct the EPA to invite comments from any requiring authority that has a designation on land to which the substantive application relates or on land adjacent to that land. The Panel considers that it is required to invite comments from Powerco under section 53(2)(l) and it has directed the EPA to do so.

[6] Under section 53(3) of the FTAA, the Panel also has discretion to invite comments from any other person the Panel considers appropriate. The Panel has considered this matter and has determined not to exercise its discretion to invite any additional parties to provide comments other than those required by the FTAA. Under section 54 of the FTAA, the invited parties have 20 working days to submit their comments which, for this Application, is no later than **9 December 2025**.

[7] Information about how to provide comments on the Application is contained in the letter from the EPA to invited parties dated 11 November 2025.

Acknowledgement of Applicant's memorandum

[8] The Panel acknowledges receipt of the Applicant's memorandum of counsel dated 7 November 2025, which makes suggestions on various procedural matters for the Panel's consideration. That memorandum will be made available on the EPA website. The Panel is open to considering suggestions by the Applicant as to how the Applicant might contribute to the efficient progress of the Application. The Panel will issue further directions on any procedural matters considered necessary and appropriate as required, and consistent with the procedural principles in section 10 of the FTAA.
