I wish to formally oppose the Northwest Rapid Transit Fast Track Application and request that the decision makers carefully consider the significant adverse effects this proposal may have on surrounding residents, landowners, and the wider community.

While I understand the need for improved transport infrastructure, I have serious concerns that this proposal appears to prioritise speed of approval over proper consideration of the long term impacts on the existing community.

My key concerns include:

1. Traffic and Access Impacts

The proposed development has the potential to significantly increase traffic congestion, affect local road safety, and create access issues for existing residents and businesses. The surrounding road network is already under pressure, and there is concern that the full cumulative effects have not been adequately addressed.

2. Noise, Vibration and Construction Effects

Both the construction phase and long term operation of the rapid transit corridor may create ongoing noise, vibration, dust, and disruption for nearby residents. These impacts can materially affect quality of life and enjoyment of homes and properties. I am already a cancer patient and I can no afford all the dust.

3. Loss of Residential Amenity and Community Character

The scale and intensity of this project may adversely affect the amenity, outlook, privacy, and character of established residential areas. Existing communities should not bear unreasonable negative effects without proper mitigation.

4. Environmental and Infrastructure Concerns

There are concerns regarding stormwater management, flooding, infrastructure capacity, and the cumulative environmental effects of the proposal. These issues require robust assessment before approval is granted.

5. Fast Track Process and Limited Community Input

The Fast Track process appears to reduce the ability of affected residents and stakeholders to have meaningful input on a project that may have permanent long term consequences for the community.



For these reasons, I oppose the application in its current form and request that decision makers either decline the application or require substantial further assessment, mitigation, and community consultation before any approval is granted.

I respectfully ask that the long term interests of existing residents, property owners, infrastructure users, and the wider community be given proper weight in this process.
