## **Details of Proposal**

Matakanui Gold Limited (**MGL**) intend to lodge an application under the Fast-Track Approvals Act 2024 (**FTA**) to authorise the Bendigo-Ophir Gold Project (**BOGP**).

MGL seeks approvals under the FTA to mine the Rise and Shine gold deposit and satellite deposits and Bendigo Station and Ardgour Station. Mining of the deposit would occur by way of an open pit mine in the first instance with a later stage for underground mining of the resource as operations advance.
