I am supportive of projects that increase the supply of housing, particularly housing options appropriate for older New Zealanders, and those that improve the provision of aged residential care facilities.

My comments are provided below for the Panel and the Developer to consider:

- I support older people being able to live independently and age in place for as long as possible. High-density, centrally located housing options deliver accommodation options and will enhance access to home and community support services.
- I note construction will be undertaken in a staged manner over a 10-year period and that amenities will be developed throughout this period. The staging of the development will need to consider existing and new residents to minimise noise and disruption to them.

Overall, the proposed development will create housing choices that are suitable for older people.
