I would like to raise serious concerns regarding the proposed fast track approval for the North West Rapid Transit project.

For the past six months, we have repeatedly raised issues regarding significant vibrations affecting our house whenever heavy vehicles, including AT buses, pass through the area. Despite these concerns being reported, no meaningful action has been taken so far.

With the proposed construction now moving forward, we are extremely concerned that the increased heavy vehicle movement and construction activity could further damage our property structure and potentially create long-term or permanent issues for both our home and the surrounding roads.

We would like to see a robust and transparent plan outlining:

- How vibration impacts will be monitored and managed
- What preventative measures will be implemented to protect nearby homes and infrastructure
- What accountability and remediation processes will be in place if damage occurs
- How the wider community will be protected from ongoing disruption and road deterioration

This project will affect everyone in the area, and residents deserve reassurance that these concerns are being taken seriously before approvals are granted.

We request that these issues be properly addressed before any fast track approval proceeds.
