Tēnā koutou,

Thank you for Minute 12.

Kōwhai Te Awhina Hapū o Te Parawhau Hapū Incorporation acknowledges receipt and confirms that it would be willing to participate in the proposed kanohi ki te kanohi hui.

The Incorporation does not seek a separate hui or site visit and would be content to participate at a venue arranged by the Panel together with other invited participants. Should any site visits be undertaken, representatives of the Incorporation would welcome the opportunity to attend.

The Incorporation does not routinely participate in panel processes of this nature but welcomes the opportunity to assist the Panel's understanding of the concerns and responsibilities outlined in its invited comments and to respond to any questions the Panel may have.

The Incorporation considers participation in the proposed hui important given its ongoing mana whenua responsibilities in relation to Te Ākau / Bream Bay and the wider receiving environment. Those responsibilities are not limited to the present application alone.

The Incorporation has also engaged with a number of significant proposals affecting the same receiving environment, including Northport expansion proposals, dry dock

and associated port infrastructure matters, transport corridor developments, and wastewater and water treatment discharge proposals.

Accordingly, the Incorporation's concerns extend to the cumulative and interrelated effects of multiple activities upon the receiving environment, taonga ecosystems, and the long-term exercise of mana whenua responsibilities.

At this stage no interpreter assistance is required.
