Dear Fast-track Team,

I am the owner of a residential rental property located on [REDACTED] in Massey, Auckland, and I wish to provide comments on the North West Rapid Transit application.

My property is situated on a cul-de-sac with a single point of vehicle access connecting to the wider road network. There is no alternative access, as the property is surrounded by neighbouring residential properties. Any disruption to this access would affect not only my property, but all properties on [REDACTED]

I am concerned that construction activities, traffic management measures, or changes to the surrounding road network may restrict, alter, or temporarily close this access. Such impacts would significantly affect tenants' ability to access and use the property and may result in rental disruption or financial loss.

I respectfully request that the Panel:

- Ensure continuous and practical vehicle access to [REDACTED] is maintained at all times, including during construction;
- Provide advance notice to residents of any temporary access restrictions;
- Minimize disruption to residential properties, particularly those with no alternative access routes.

Given the reliance of all residents on a single access point, I ask that this matter be carefully considered in the design and construction planning stages.

I would appreciate being kept informed of any developments that may affect access to my property.
