Re: Haldon Solar Farm - Interim Response Following Conditions Workshop

Dear Panel,

Thank you for the opportunity to participate in the conditions workshop on 28 July 2026. We consider that the workshop made useful progress in clarifying the remaining matters relating to the Technical Review Panel.

Lodestone is now working with its ecological and planning advisers to prepare targeted amendments to the consent conditions. Those amendments will clarify:

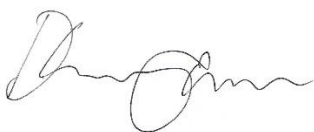
- the technical composition and role of the Technical Review Panel;
- the objectives and outcomes against which monitoring results are to be assessed; and
- the relevant thresholds and triggers for further management responses.

Much of this technical framework has been contained in the ecological management plans provided in April 2026. The proposed amendments will bring the key elements that appropriately sit at condition level into the consent conditions, without unnecessarily duplicating the detailed methodologies and response measures contained in the management plans.

Lodestone intends to provide the Panel with an updated condition set by the close of business 30 July 2026. The response will identify only the conditions for which amendments are proposed, so the changes can be readily reviewed. Should the Panel wish to seek comment from the workshop participants on the amended conditions, Lodestone considers that up to two working days would be sufficient for targeted commentary.

We thank the Panel and the workshop participants for their constructive engagement.
