1 Introduction

- 1.1 My name is Jason Keyte. I hold the position of Auckland Ground Engineering and Tunnelling Lead at AECOM.
- 1.2 I have not previously prepared a report in relation to the Application. I have provided advice to NZTA in relation to the notice of requirement for Stage 2 of the Mill Road Corridor. I have provided NZTA review comments on the geotechnical assessment presented in LDE's Initial Geotechnical Assessment Report (December 2024), Addendum Geotechnical Assessment Report (August 2025) and Slope Stability Assessment Memorandum (August 2025). Further reference documents related to the Sunfield development have been reviewed as part of the review process.
