
**MINUTE 10 OF THE KAIMAI HYDRO-ELECTRIC POWER
SCHEME EXPERT PANEL**

Minor Corrections

FTAA-2502-1024

15 June 2026

[1] On 15 May 2026 the Panel granted the approvals sought for the Kaimai Hydroelectric Power Scheme, subject to conditions that were, for the most part, agreed between the Applicant and the parties (Decision).

[2] Section 89 of the FTAA provides that the Panel may, within 20 working days after issuing a decision document under section 88(1), issue an amendment to the document to correct minor omissions, errors, or other defects in it.

[3] The Panel has received the requests for corrections from the following:

- (a) The Applicant, dated 22 May 2026, and
- (b) Bay of Plenty Regional Council (BOPRC), dated 22 May 2026

[4] The Panel has considered the requested changes and is satisfied that the errors ought to be corrected and fall within the amendments contemplated by s 89(1) of the FTAA.

[5] The Applicant's requests relate to the conditions and primarily identify minor errors, omissions and drafting inconsistencies. The Panel accepts all requests made by the Applicant.

[6] BOPRC requests relate to minor administrative amendments such as typographical and minor grammatical errors and inconsistencies. The Panel accepts all requests made by the BOPRC.
