Para 263	“We have not materially amended the Designation conditions proposed by NZTA, other than to include the VEMP in condition 3(h) which lists the management plans to be included in the Outline Plan.”	“We have not materially amended the Designation conditions proposed by NZTA, other than to include the VEMP in condition 3(h) which lists the management plans to be included in the Outline Plan. ”	The VEMP is not listed in condition 3(h) and paragraph 633 states that the Panel accepted NZTA's suggested amendments to the designation conditions (which deleted references to the VEMP from condition 3(h)). It is not clear whether this inconsistency is an error, or whether it is addressed by paras 626 and 627 of the Decision (i.e. the Panel hadn't revised Parts B to L). To avoid potential confusion for future readers of the Decision, NZTA suggests a clarifying note or footnote is added to para 263.
Para 333	“Hence, we included conditions in the CRC consents that require offsetting of at least 2.6 ha of wetland, 0.19 ha of stream bed and 2.5 ha of riparian planting, and 6 ha of lizard habitat.”	“Hence, we included conditions in the CRC consents that require offsetting of at least <u>0.742-6</u> ha of wetland, <u>0.180-19</u> ha of stream bed and <u>2.5</u> ha of riparian planting, and <u>56</u> ha of lizard habitat.”	These areas were updated in the final conditions to reflect the no-net-loss figures. It is not clear whether this inconsistency is an error, or whether it is addressed by paras 626 and 627 of the Decision (i.e. the Panel hadn't revised Parts B to L). To avoid potential confusion for future readers of the Decision, NZTA suggests a clarifying note or footnote is added to para 333.
