

Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 – Addendum to Treaty settlements and other obligations (Section 18) report

Points of clarification

1. Under section 18 of the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 ('the Act'), the Ministry for the Environment prepared a Treaty settlements and other obligations report, dated 9 June 2025, for the FTAA-2504-1042 POTL – Stella Passage Development substantive application. This addendum provides clarification on two matters in that report, as requested by you in Minute 3, issued on 11 July 2025.

Treaty settlement entities

- 2. Paragraph 15 of the section 18 report sets out the definition of "Treaty settlement entity" under the Act, which includes a post-settlement governance entity (PSGE).
- 3. Paragraph 16.c of the section 18 report identifies Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Ranginui Settlement Trust ('the Settlement Trust') as the PSGE representing the hapū of Ngāti Ranginui under the Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Ranginui Claims Settlement Act 2025 ('the Settlement Act'). The Settlement Act provides for a custodian trustee, currently the Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Ranginui Settlement Trustee Limited, to receive redress, primarily the vesting of cultural redress properties and the transfer of commercial redress properties.
- 4. The Settlement Act also contemplates that settlement property may be on-transferred, or the rights and obligations relating to the redress may be assigned, to a 'hapū entity', who represent a hapū of Ngāti Ranginui, as determined by the trustees of the Settlement Trust. However, we are not in a position to confirm whether this may have occurred post-settlement. Accordingly, based on the information available to us, the Settlement Trust is the relevant Treaty settlement entity for Ngā Hapū o Ngāti Ranginui.

Te Maunga o Mauao Mātaitai Reserve

5. Paragraphs 23 and 60 of the section 18 report state that the project area overlaps with Te Maunga o Mauao Mātaitai Reserve. While the Mātaitai Reserve overlaps the general port location (as depicted in Figure 2 of the applicant's report dated 14 April 2025, and reproduced at Attachment 2 of the section 18 report), we wish to clarify that it does not appear to overlap with the project area itself.
